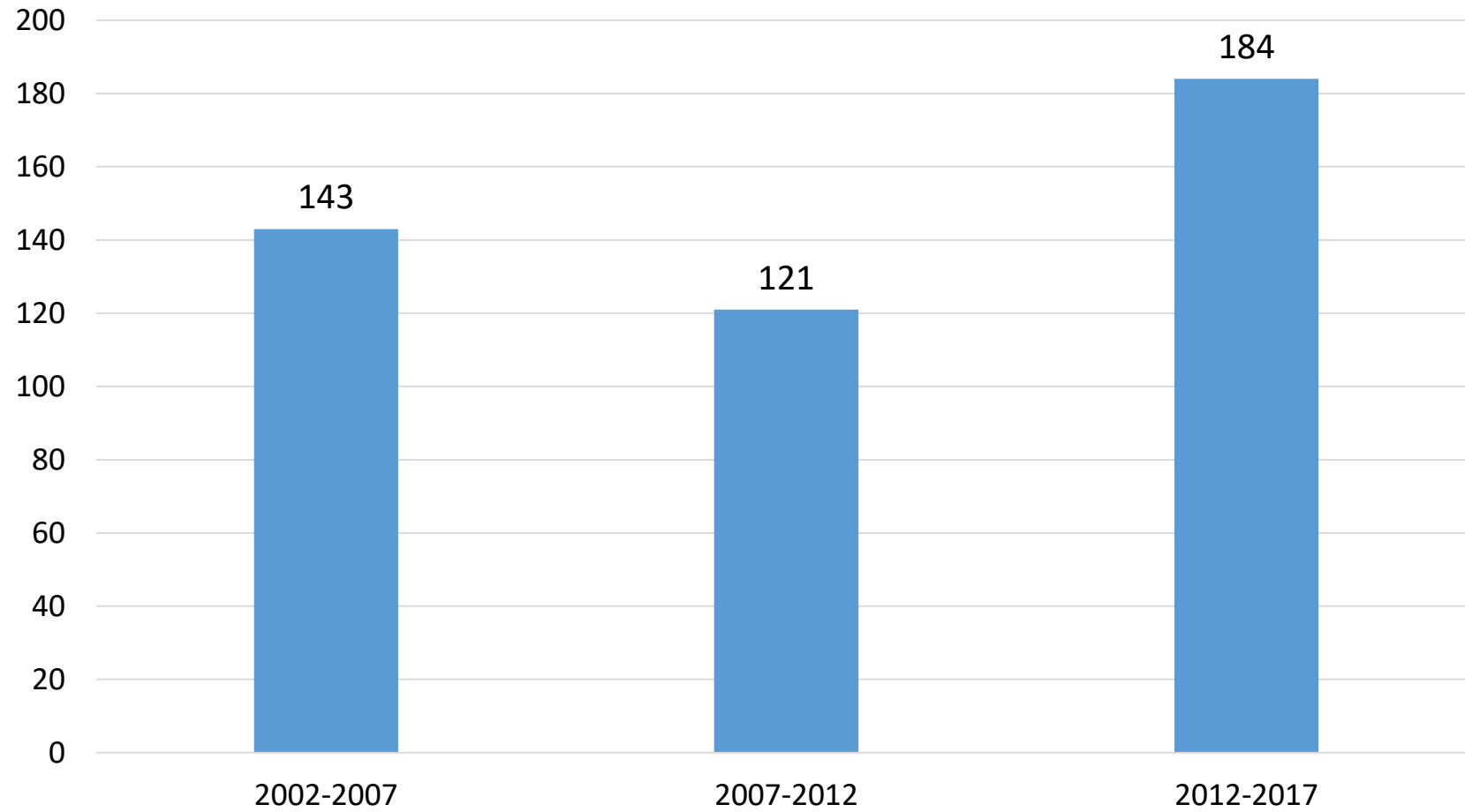

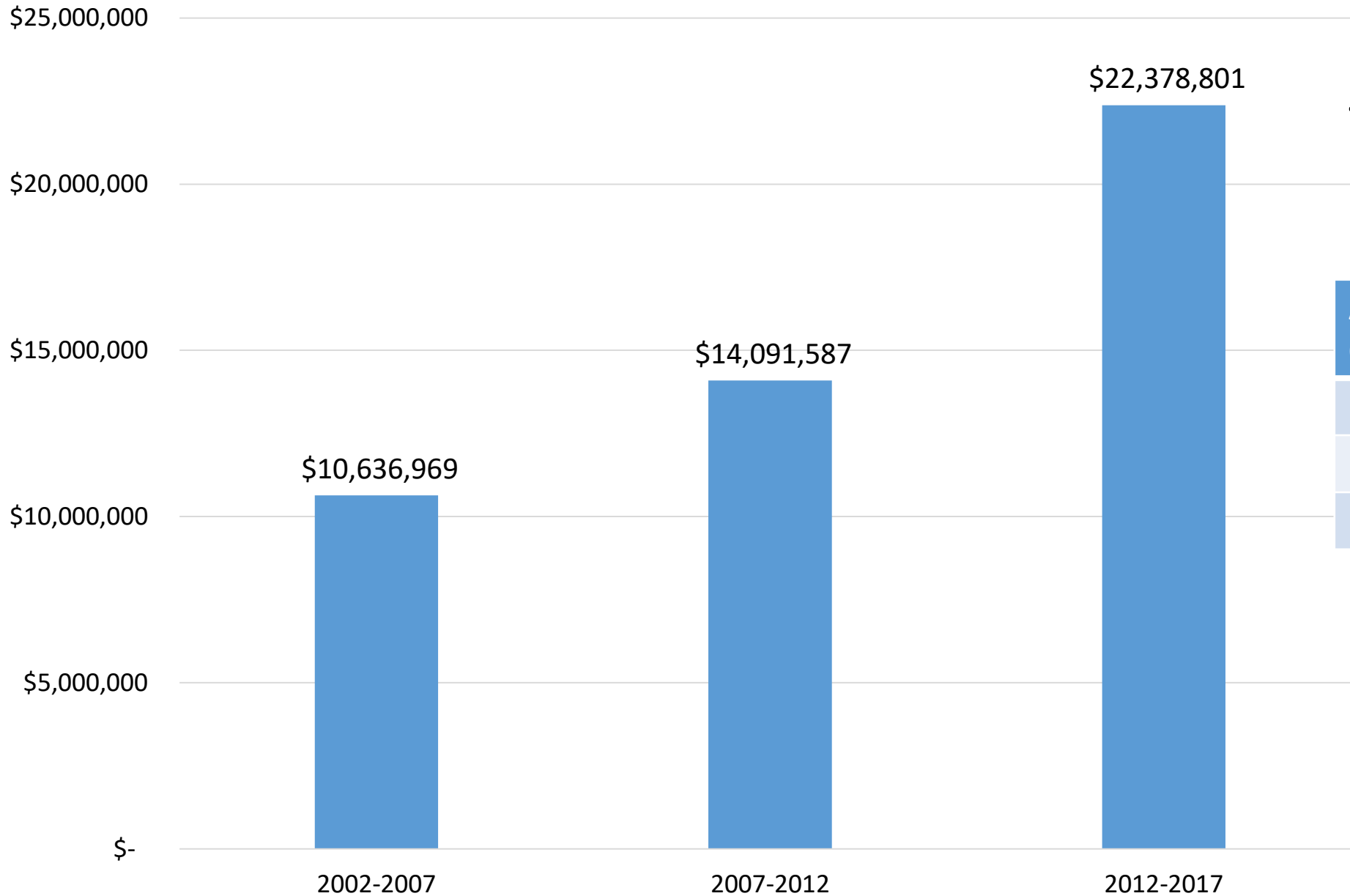
1. Number of Projects by Agreement Cycle

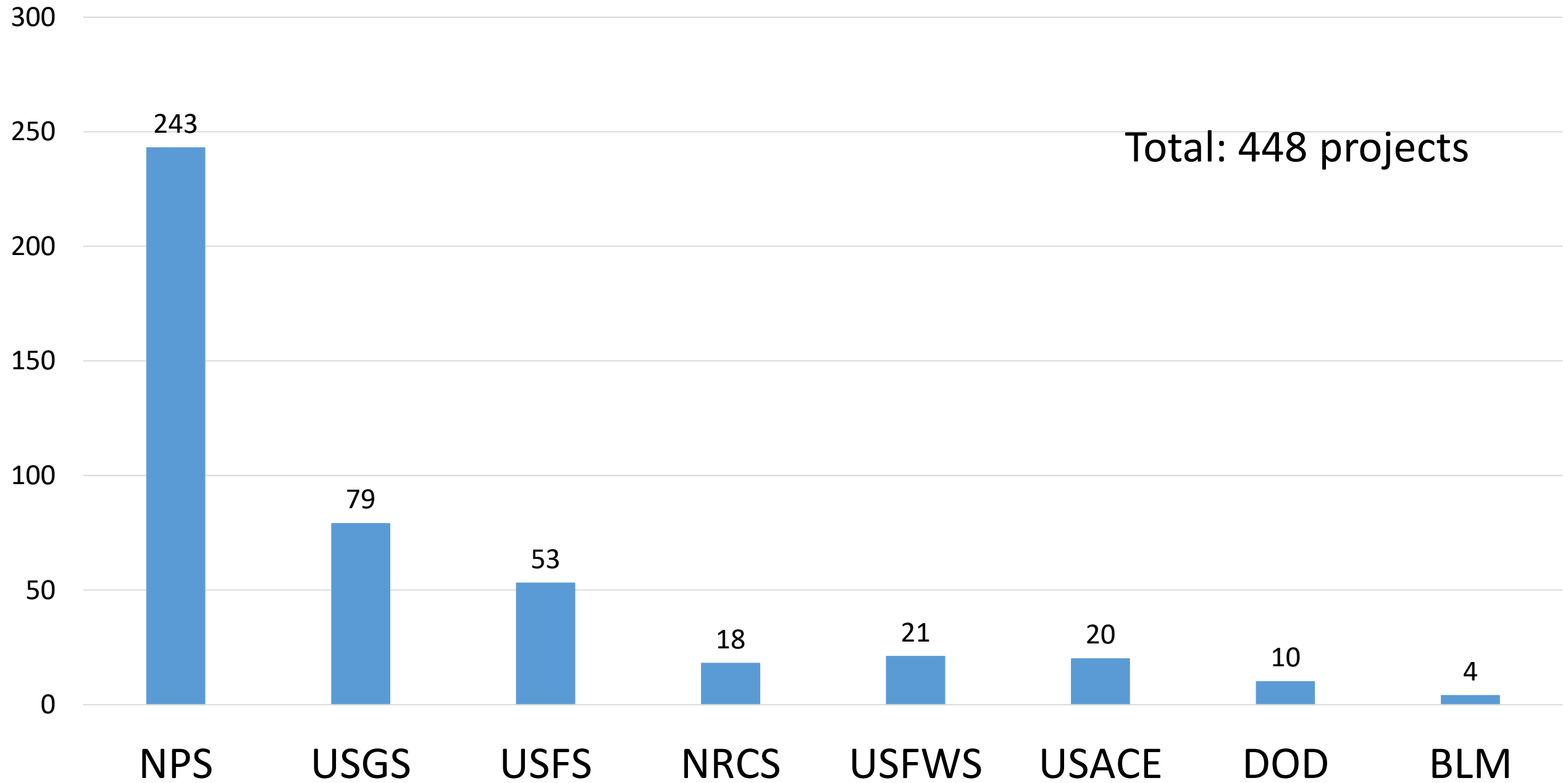
2. Funding Totals by Agreement Cycle



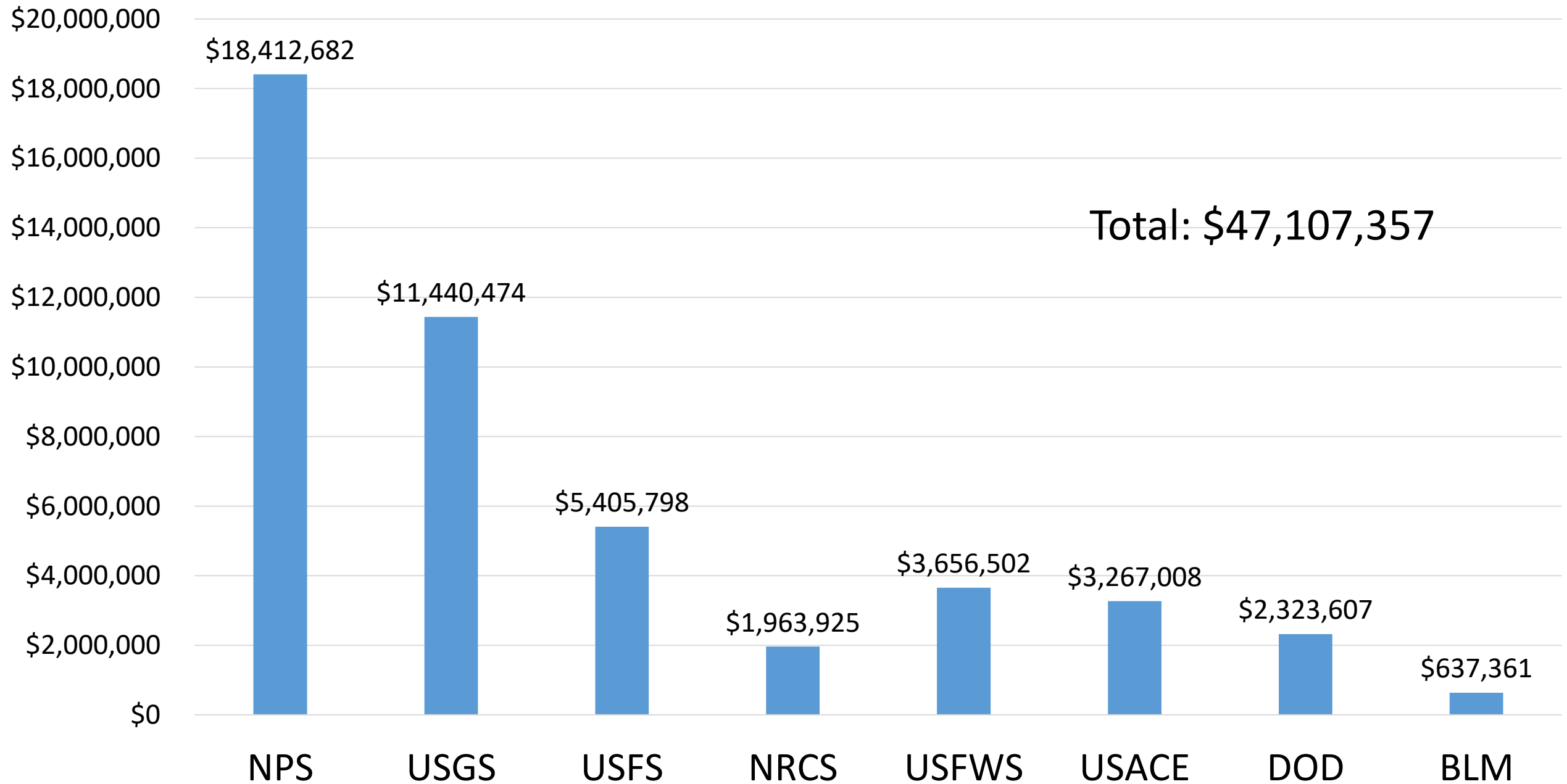

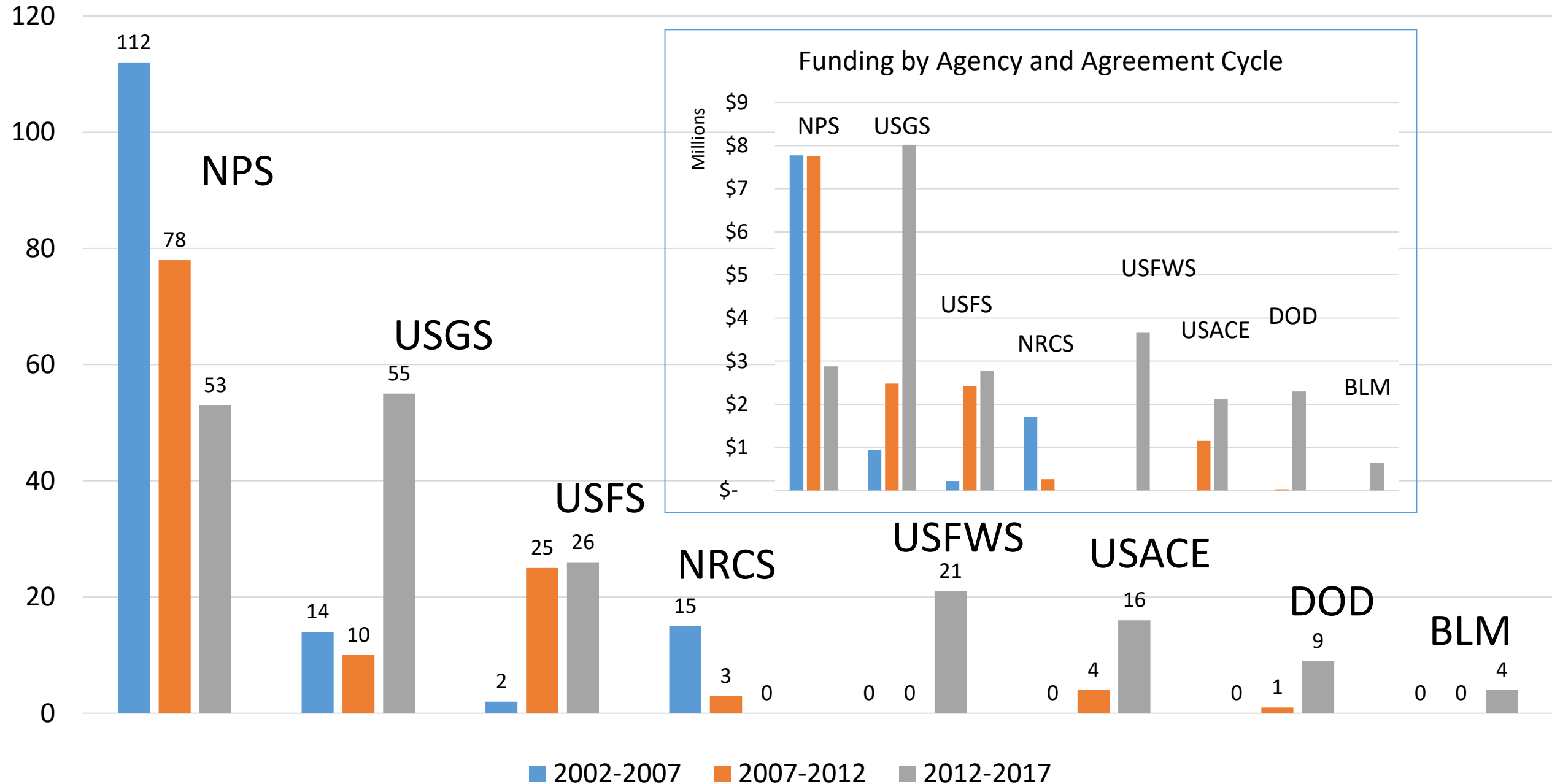
3. 2002-2017 Number of Projects by Agency



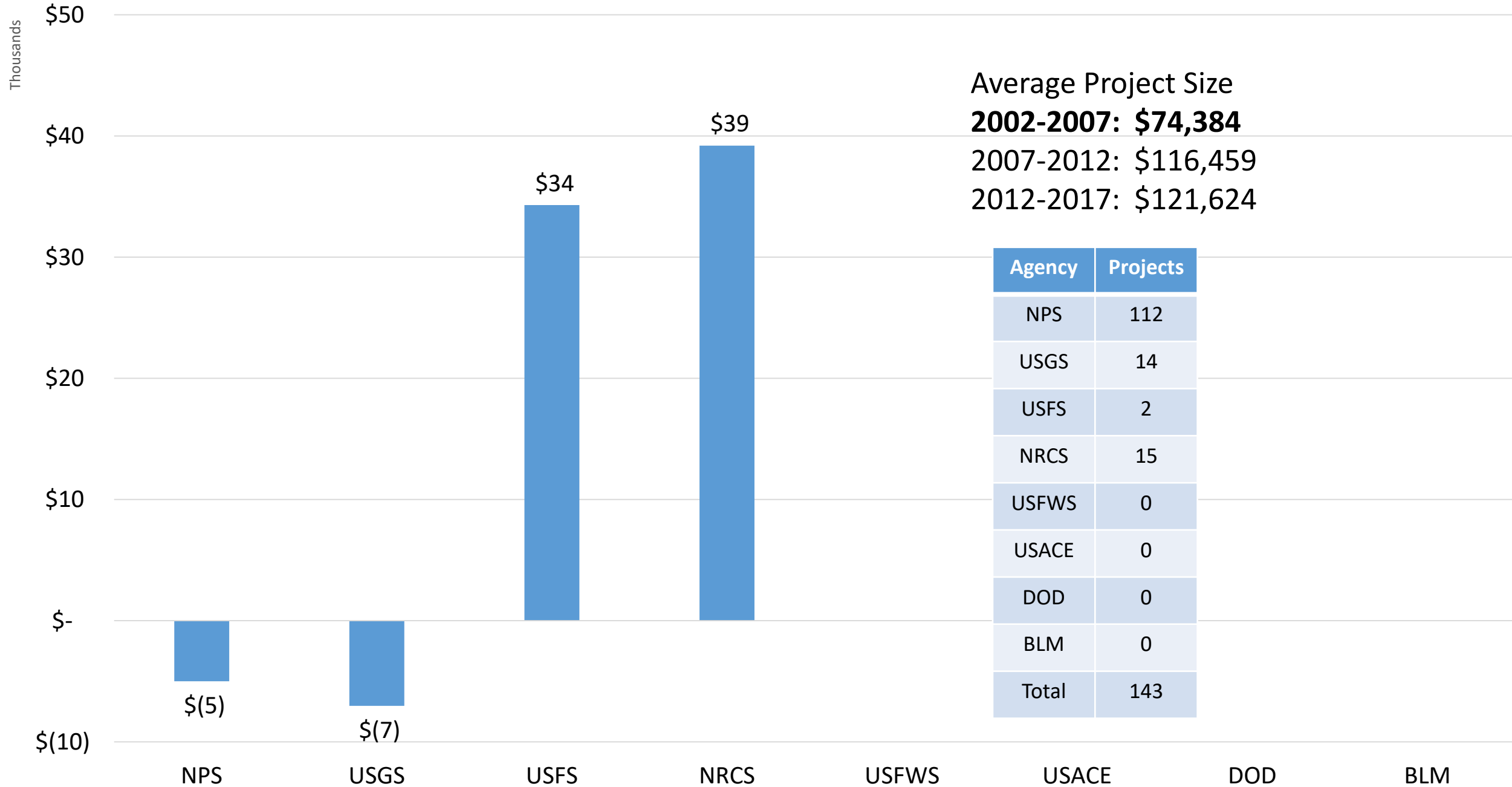
4. 2002-2017 Funding



5. Number of Projects by Agency and Agreement Cycle

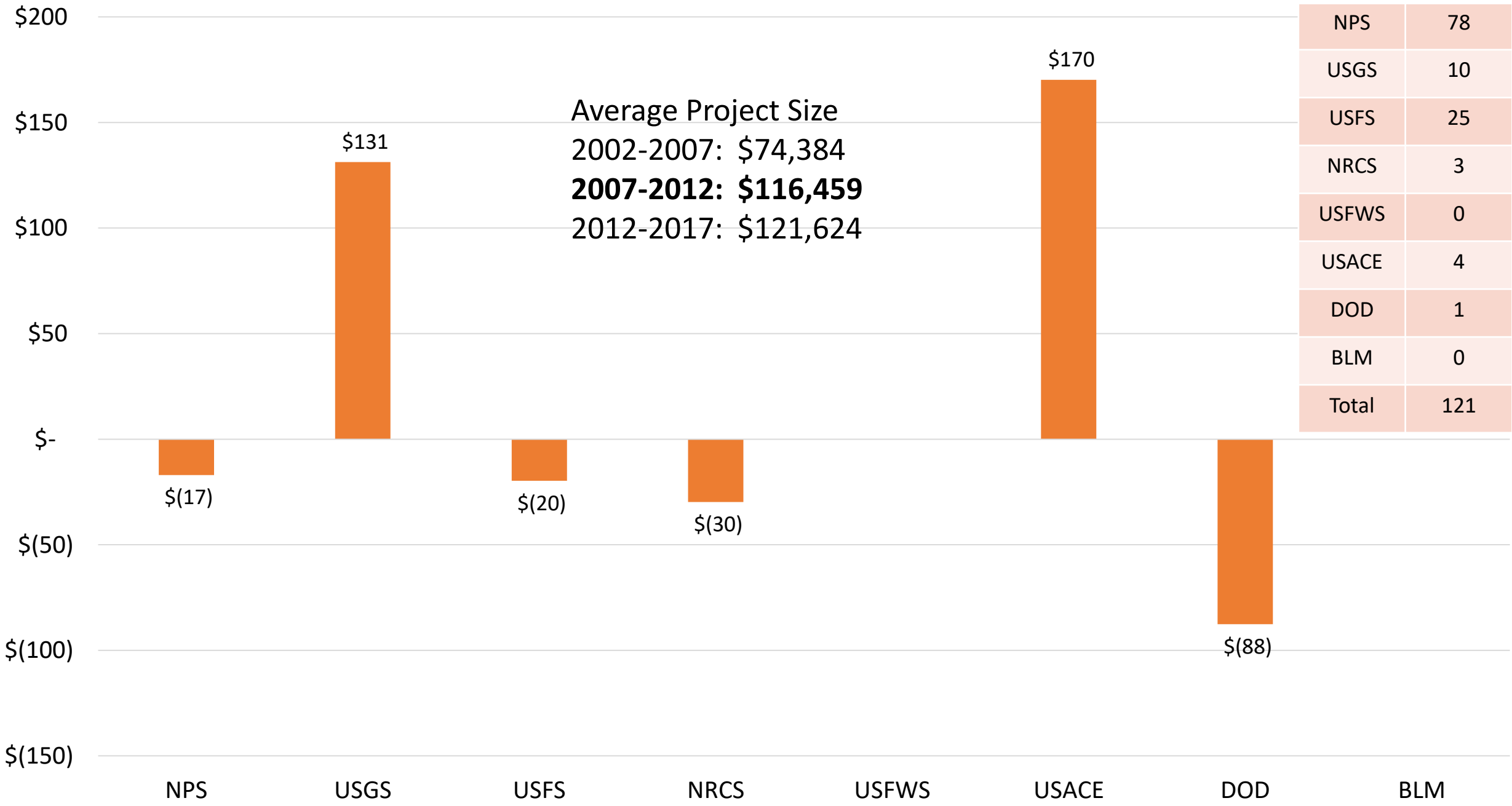


6. Average project size by agency compared to overall mean 2002-2007



7. Average project size by agency compared to overall mean 2007-2012

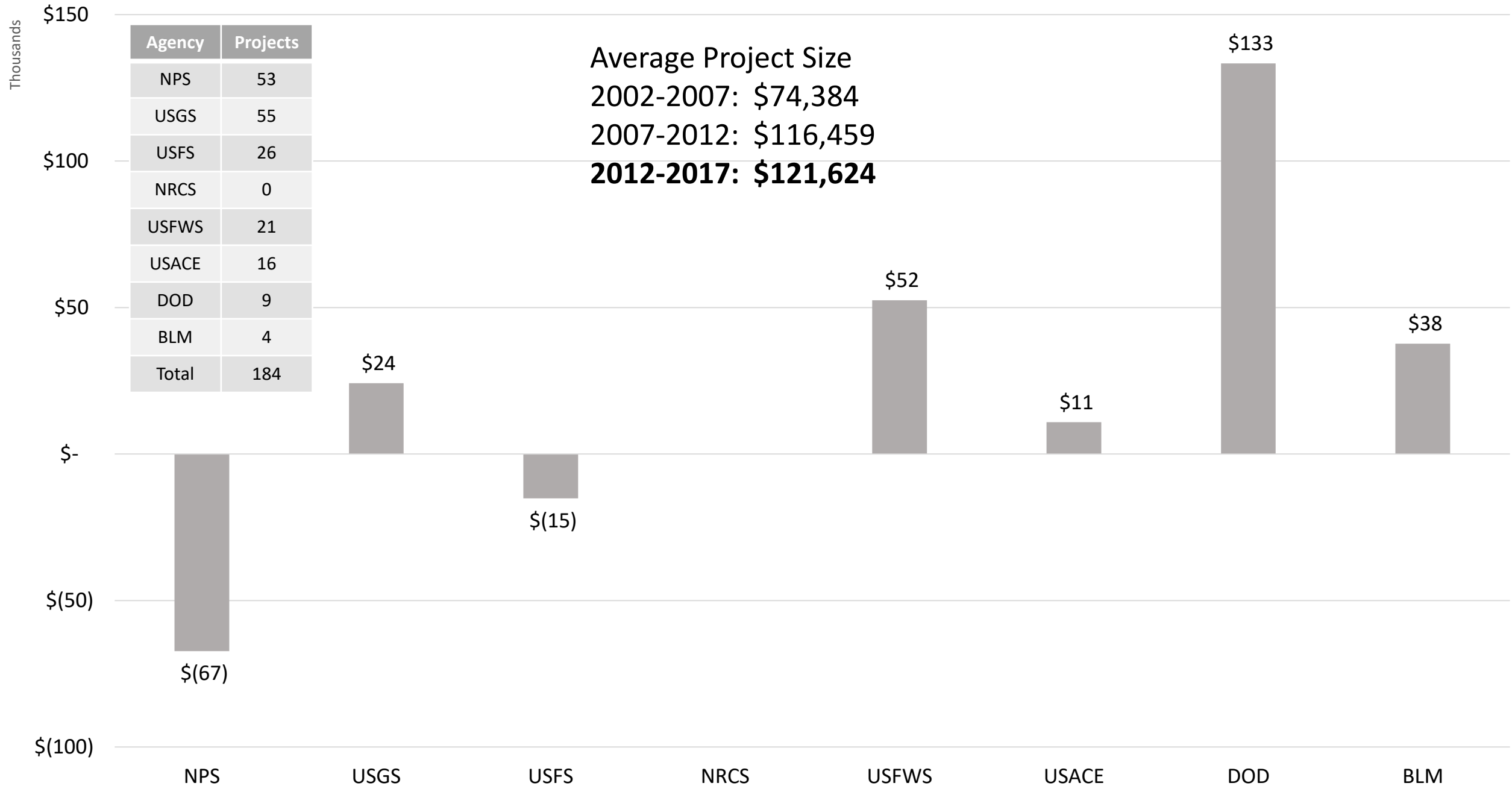

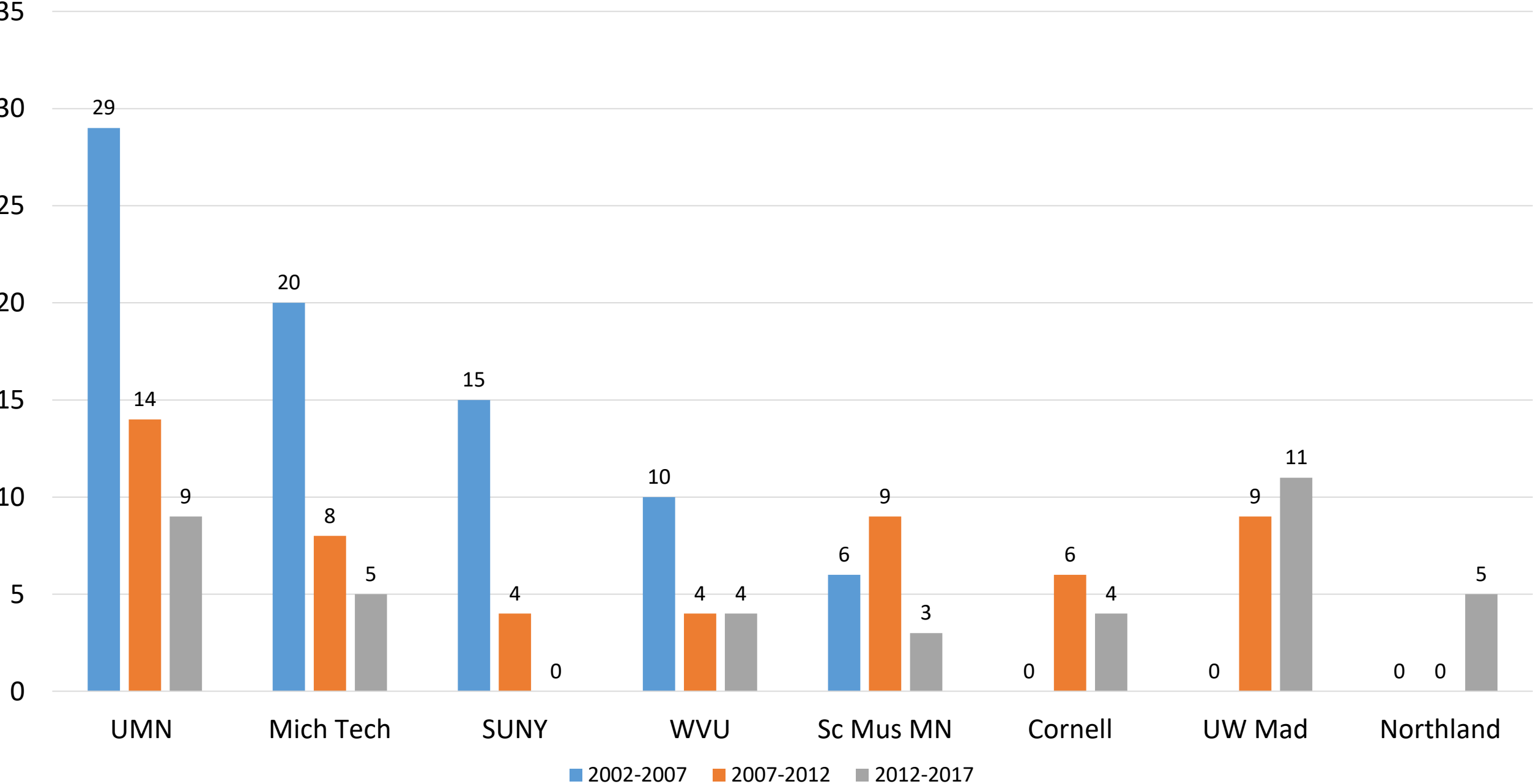

10. Conclusions

- Project funding and partners have steadily increased over 3 agreement cycles; 30-57, \$10.6-\$22.4mil
- NPS, USGS, and USFS have historically been our most active federal partners
- NPS leads in number of projects, but has relatively small awards; both number and size of projects continue to decline
- USGS and USFWS are becoming more active at a rapid pace
- DOD, USACE and BLM are relatively inactive, but their small number of projects are quite large
- UMN and MTU have historically been our most active non-federal partners
- UW-Madison and MSU are more active in recent years
- SMM most active organization
